IMPORTANT

Water Saving Appliance Rebate Program Information

Rebates are issued on a first come, first serve basis, provided funding is available, and also provided the applicant meets all qualifying criteria. There is no implied or expressed guarantee that funding will be available at the time the application is processed. The rebate amount is \$100 per toilet **or** the cost of the toilet tank, bowl, seat, wax seal, supply line, angle stop, plumbing permit, and installation by a licensed plumber, whichever is less. The rebate program also offers rebates of \$100 for the following qualifying devices: ultra-low water consumption dishwashers; ultra-low consumption washing machines; and hot water demand pumping systems that have EnergyStar rating. Rebates of \$25 may be available for each 100 gallons of rainwater storage capacity in a cistern system (up to a maximum storage capacity of 3,000 gallons). *Please refer to District Rule 11 for definitions of ultra-low consumption appliances.*

Rebate Eligibility Requirements:

- ❑ The qualifying devices must be installed in a building supplied by a water distribution system or private well that derives water from the Monterey Peninsula Water Resources System (MPWRS) or is supplied as a sub-unit of the California-American Water Company within the boundaries of the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District (i.e. Bishop, Hidden Hills, and Ryan Ranch water systems). Private wells outside the Carmel Valley Alluvial Aquifer are exempt from these systems. If you need further information to determine eligibility, **please call 658-5601.**
- ❑ Applications for rebates must be received within **90 days** following purchase of qualifying devices. Applicants agree to install the fixture and/or appliance at the property listed on the application form. Applicants certify under the penalty of perjury that the information on the application is true and complete.
- ❑ Replacement of an ultra-low flush (1.6 gallons-per-flush) toilet with a dual-flush ultra-low flush toilet qualifies for a rebate.
- ❑ Properties previously subjected to the Water Management District toilet replacement requirement are only eligible for a rebate if the application is for dual-flush ultra-low flow toilets.
- ❑ **These conditions shall disqualify the application for rebate:**
 1. Properties that have transferred ownership or changed use or expanded the use by adding a bathroom or 25% or more of the existing square-footage before the rebate application is processed.
 2. Properties that received a water permit between 1985 and 1987 and a connection charge reduction was allowed due to voluntary installation of ULF toilets.
 3. Properties that were required to replace toilets as a condition of a water rationing variance (Rule 92).
- ❑ Non-residential toilet replacement rebates are limited to 20 toilets per site. Apartments are considered residential property and are not limited to a maximum of 20 toilet rebates.
 1. Visitor-serving commercial properties were required to retrofit toilets to 1.6 gallons as of December 31, 2000. (Visitor-serving facilities include: all hotels, motels, restaurants, convention/meeting facilities, and service stations within the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District).
- ❑ Rebates shall not be issued for more than 3,000 gallons of cistern storage capacity on a site.
- ❑ **Rebates shall not be issued for the replacement of existing qualifying devices or for qualifying devices required as a condition of a water permit issued prior to December 1, 2003.**

TO APPLY FOR A REBATE:

1. Purchase and install the qualifying devices.
2. Complete this form. Please attach the sales receipt for all covered materials, and **return the white copy** of the application to the Water Management District for processing. ***Keep the yellow copy for your records.***
3. Consent for an inspection of the property may be necessary to process the rebate application. A representative of the Water Management District will contact you to verify the installation of the new appliances. **A site inspection is required for all applications for cistern rebates before the rebate request will be considered.**
4. Allow at least four weeks for a decision on your application for a rebate.
5. Recycle you old toilets through the Marina landfill. Remove all plastic and metal parts before delivery.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: *Accepting a rebate for an ultra-low consumption appliances does not disqualify the property from residential water credits associated with the appliance (contact District office for more information.) Although there are presently no credit programs available for replacing older toilets with ULF models, choosing to accept a rebate for a residential toilet could result in the loss of credits, which might be available in the future to offset new water fixtures (i.e. tubs, sinks, etc.). The loss of such credits could prevent future remodeling and/or addition of water fixtures and could affect the property's value if the property is sold before new water supplies are available.*

This is a program to provide financial assistance to water users wishing to voluntarily install ultra-low consumption appliances. Monterey Peninsula Water Management District administers the expanded rebate program. California-American Water Company participates in the toilet rebate program. Installation is the sole responsibility of the applicant, as is the determination of the adequacy and compatibility of the existing plumbing system. Monterey Peninsula Water Management District and California-American Water Company assume no responsibility or liability for any damages that may occur to an applicant's property as a result of this program. Due to circumstances beyond the control of Monterey Peninsula Water Management District and California-American Water Company, there is no guarantee that the installation of ultra-low consumption appliances will result in lower utility costs.

NOTICE: *The decision to grant or deny a rebate is a determination of the Water District's General Manager. Determinations of the General Manager may be appealed to the District Board within twenty-one (21) days after any such determination pursuant to District Rule 70.
